- [TSA PreCheck & Global Entry](#) — Less fumbling, more breathing room.
- [Airport Lounges with Day Passes](#) — Priority Pass, Amex, or airline lounges can change the pre-flight mood.

For the Cultural Adventurer


“Europe by train sounds dreamy—until you’re sprinting with luggage and no signs in English.”

- [Eurail Senior Pass](#) — Reserved seats at lower rates.
- [Amtrak/VIA Rail](#) — Discounts for 60+ and accessible seating.
- [Local Transit Secrets](#) — Stockholm and Tokyo offer free or discounted senior fares with an ID.

For the Cruise Enthusiast

“Booking a cruise room without checking for roll-in showers was the last time I winged it.”

- [Step-Free Cabins](#) — Ask specifically—some ships only have a handful.
- [Mobility Rentals Delivered to Cabins](#) — Like scooters from Scootaround.
- [Escorted Embarkation](#) — Available if requested ahead of time.

One copy printed. One shared with a loved one. Bonus: Add your meds and emergency contacts.
